 Gather the required documents and apply for admissions, for example: Academic qualifications and results English Certificates. If required, you must take an English Test. Passport and other personal information.
☐ If sucessful, receive your Letter of Offer and accept the Offer.
☐ Make the initial Pre-Paid tuition fee and organise your Overseas Student Healthy Cover (OSHC).
☐ One you receive your Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE), apply for your Student Visa.
